## *In Antarctica from 2020*

This revolutionary and stylish cruise ship combines the advantages of a small expedition vessel with the stability and comfort of a larger cruise ship. With a maximum capacity of 189 passengers, this compact-design ship offers an intimate atmosphere with great personal service. It is easy to get around without any crowds and waiting lines. At the same time, it offers the stability and smooth ride of a bigger ship, while also offering all the luxury comforts of today.

### **A VESSEL SPECIFICALLY DESIGNED TO OPTIMIZE THE EXPEDITION EXPERIENCE:**

The Ocean Victory is foremost designed to provide a better expedition experience than any other ship. The patented X-bow provides a more comfortable sailing and helps to prevent passengers' discomforts, a great feature when crossing the notorious Drake passage!

Additionally, it helps to keep our speed and planned expedition schedule in rough seas. As a side benefit, the X-bow design means that our guests practically have no obstacle in their way when standing on the viewing platforms, meaning we bring them closer to birds and wildlife.

The revolutionary Rolls Royce Zero-Speed stabilizers also provide more comfort and deliver a proven reduction of the "ship roll" of 80% to 85%. These stabilizers function also when the ship is not moving. Combined with the benefits of dynamic positioning and in total five zodiac loading locations, we can deliver zodiac operations faster than any other vessel with a comparable size. This means our passengers spend more time exploring the unique wonders of Antarctica, and we don't miss any unexpected wildlife sightseeing opportunities. The vessel's compact design and high maneuverability mean that we can explore deeper and further into the most remote areas.

### **ALL THE COMFORTS OF MODERN LUXURY CRUISING:**

With a total of 93 comfortable and spacious state rooms for our guests, all with an unobstructed panoramic view of the ocean, most with their own balcony, two restaurants, a wellness area including a heated swimming pool, two jacuzzies and a spa, an Albatros Nordic Bar and a modern lecture lounge, this ship truly delivers on all the comfort needs of today's explorers.

### **ONE OF THE MOST ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY VESSELS**

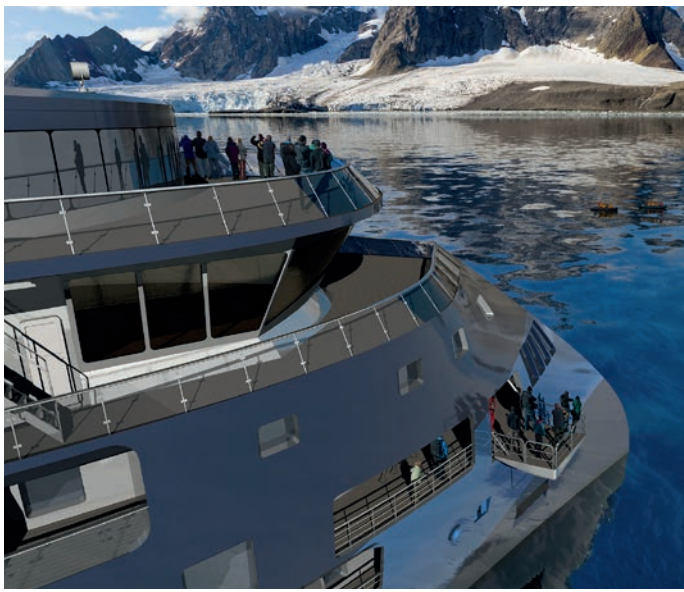

The ship is clean ship certified and has tier-3 compliant engines, the least polluting engines in the world, leading up to 80% lower emissions than traditional expedition vessels. The engines of the Ocean Victory also only use light fuels (MGO).

Albatros Expeditions implements a complete "Green Initiative Program" onboard, that includes removal of single use plastics, only using bio-degradable and eco-friendly products, offering sustainable seafood and organic fair-trade coffee and teas. Additionally, our CSR program organizes fundraising initiatives in support of organizations and projects that protect our environment locally and globally.

### **NOW, FOR THE TECHNICAL DETAILS:**

With the highest Polar code 6 and Ice class 1A, Ocean Victory is the ideal vessel for small-ship expedition cruising due to her sturdy construction and X-Bow®-Infinity class. It provides high stability in rough weather and allows for the smoothest movements on high waves, and a Solas classification including all "safe return to port" safety features. The vessel is part of a brand-new generation of low-energy vessels, with 4 diesel and 2 electro engines, all controlled electronically to optimize speed and fuel consumption.



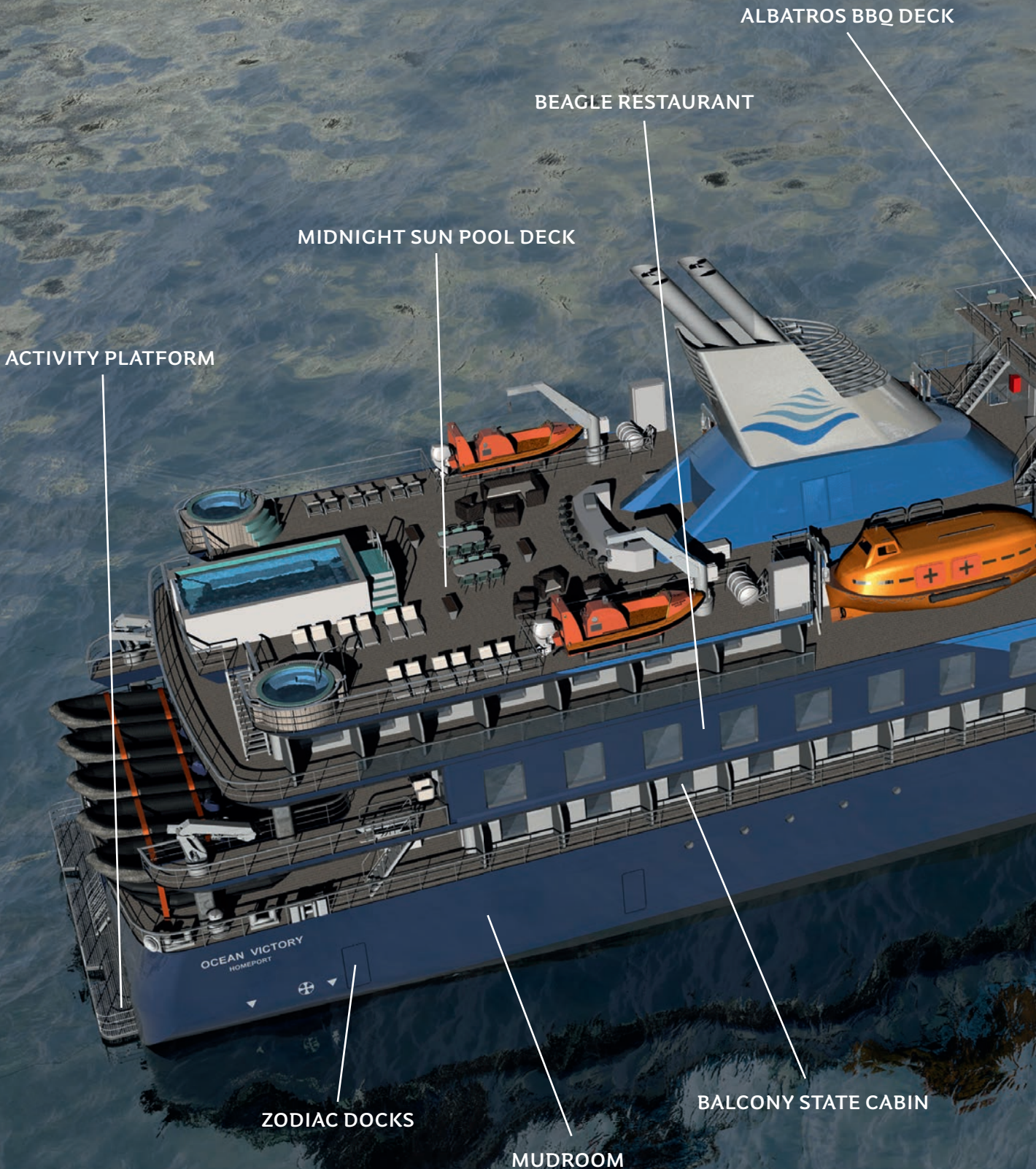

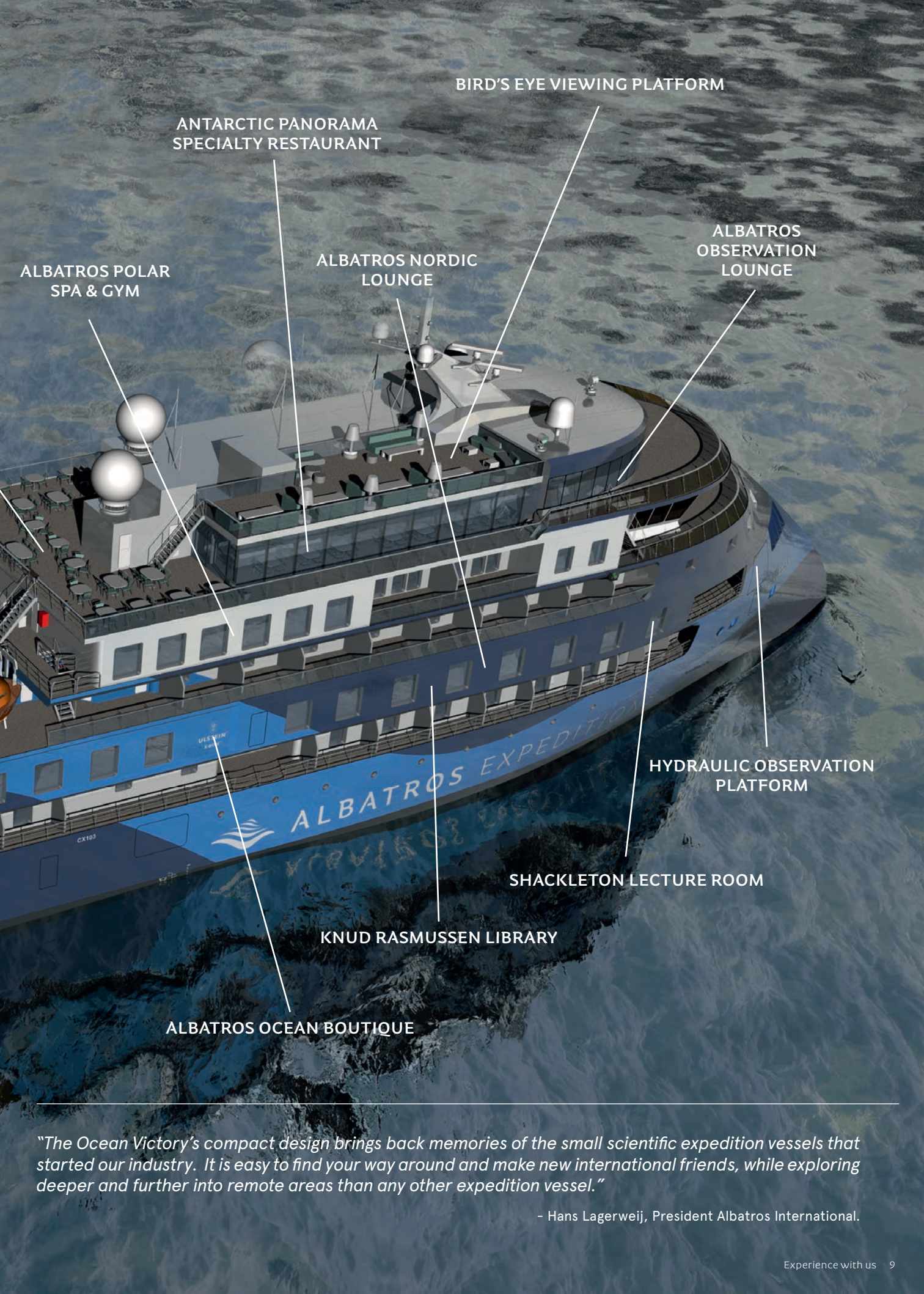

The result is a freshly grilled, healthy and nutritious meal with a sensational taste.

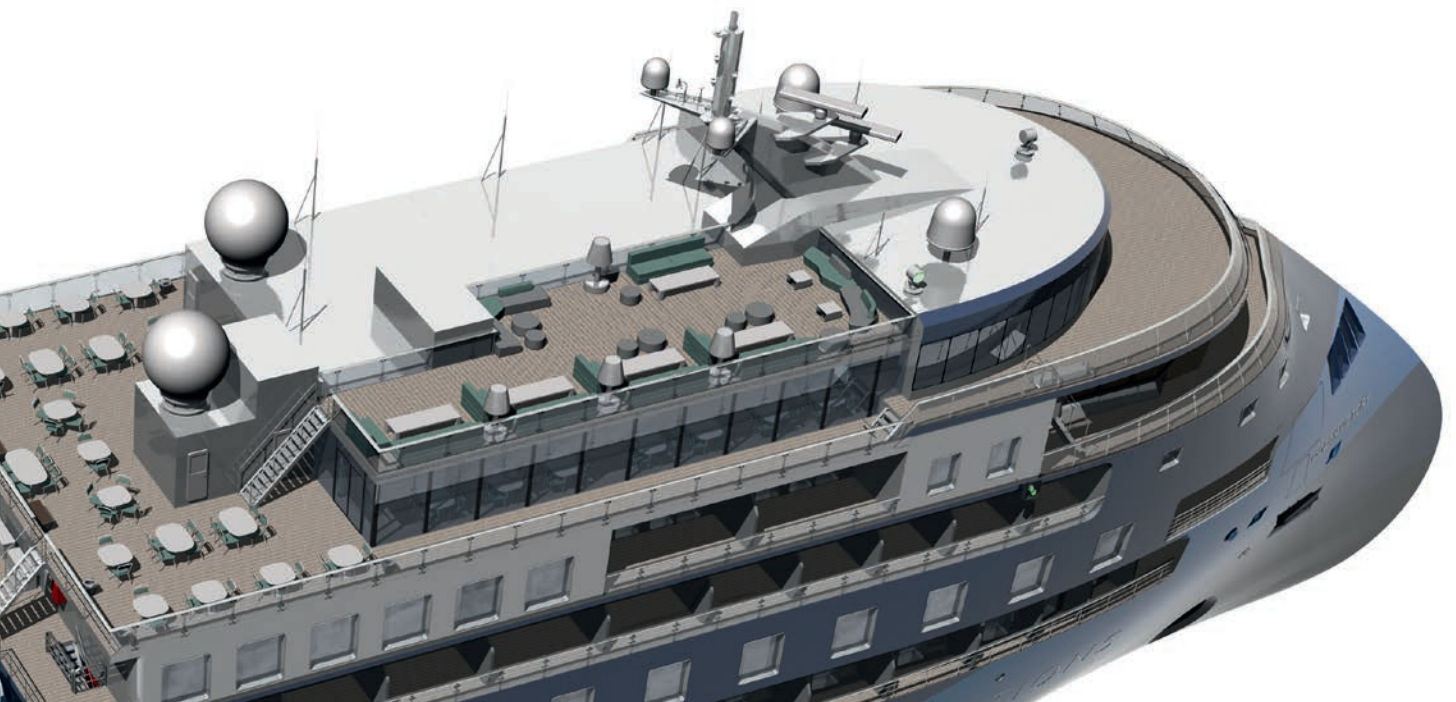

# Zodiac & Hydraulic observation platforms

The Ocean Victory offers an unbeatable expedition experience, due to its rapid zodiac loading arrangement and its fantastic observation areas, including unique hydraulic platforms:

Plenty of observation deck space, including the exclusive deck 9 "bird's eye viewing platform", and the unique front location hydraulic observation platforms. These give our guests a better, closer and fully unobstructed views of icebergs, birds and whales, bringing them closer to the majesty of Antarctic nature.

The combination of zero-speed stabilizers, dynamic positioning ("virtual anchoring") and five zodiac loading platforms, means that our guests can be in their zodiacs faster than any other ship of a comparable size. This implies we not only spend more time off the ship exploring, but also can react faster when unexpected wildlife encounters happen.

# SOLAR ECLIPSE, SOUTH GEORGIA & ANTARCTICA

15 DAYS EXPEDITION CRUISE

December 4, 2021, a total solar eclipse will run over the South Atlantic towards Antarctica. Albatros Expeditions will be in place exactly at the center of the eclipse umbra during our fantastic voyage to South Georgia and Antarctica. The eclipse begins early in the morning east of Falkland Islands. From here the moon shadow speeds south at 10,000 km per hour towards the South Orkney Island and Antarctica. Albatros Expeditions has selected the best possible observation position east of South Orkney, where the sun is 11 degrees above the horizon. The solar eclipse is just one out of several highlights of this 15-days, once-in-a-lifetime voyage.

We follow the path of the courageous explorer Sir Ernest Shackleton – just in the opposite direction: From Ushuaia to the wildlife paradise of South Georgia. From here to the eclipse path and onwards to South Shetland Islands and the Antarctic Peninsula. We will skirt the periphery of the Weddell Sea, birthplace of the mighty tabular icebergs, and cruise close to Shackleton's harsh winter-camp on the shore of Elephant Island.

The sub-Antarctic islands and Antarctic Peninsula are a nature photographer's paradise and we will attempt as many shore landings as possible per day, weather conditions permitting, bringing you close to Antarctica's beauty. Her high maneuverability, shallow draft and strong engines allow for extended voyages into isolated fjords, creating exciting adventures for any polar explorer.



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# THE GREEN INITIATIVE PROGRAM

To keep our oceans clean and as unpolluted as possible, and in collaboration with the hotel management onboard, we want our guests to gain awareness of the positive impact we are making together with the following actions:

## **SAVE THE WAVES PROGRAM**

In order to reduce chemicals released into the ocean and lower the energy used in washing items onboard, the washing of towels and bed linens is being reduced, by providing each cabin proper signage to reduce the amount being washed each time. All laundry chemicals used are biodegradable.

## **RECYCLING PROGRAM**

The 3 keywords to keep in mind in every aspect are: Reuse, Reduce, Recycle. All possible items are put to multiple use. For example, plastic bags from parka jackets are used afterwards as garbage bin liners. All single use plastic items are not in use, such as disposable cups, stirrers and straws. Paper cups can be used when requested, refillable water bottles are given to all our guests at the beginning of each voyage, and only reusable hard plastic mugs and regular glasses are used for BBQs and special events. Only paper straws are available upon request and proper signage has been located explaining this. Wooden items have replaced the plastic ones, and instead of individual packages for condiments, yogurt, jam or butter, we provide small bowls and a butter pot for each table.

All garbage created in work areas is separated, and trash bins in the cabins can be requested to separate paper products. We are implementing recycling stations in key public areas for the use of our guests.

## **SUSTAINABLE SEAFOOD**

We only prepare seafood that is either caught or farmed in ways that consider the long-term vitality of harvested species and the well-being of our oceans, as well as the livelihoods of fisheries-dependent communities. The hotel management uses MSC (Marine Stewardship Council) to ensure the purchase of species approved as sustainable.

## **TOILET AMENITIES**

Single use and plastic items have been replaced by wall-mounted dispensers to eliminate waste, and only biodegradable products are used, with proper labeling to promote the awareness of green initiatives among our guests.

## **CLEANING AND LAUNDRY CHEMICALS**

Phosphate free, non or minimally toxic, biodegradable, not bio accumulative and eco-friendly cleaning products only. Preventive measures to avoid the spread of plastic microfibers in the oceans are being researched and are in the process of being implemented.

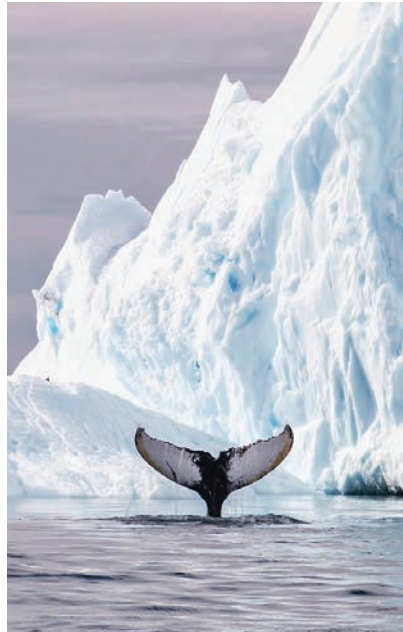

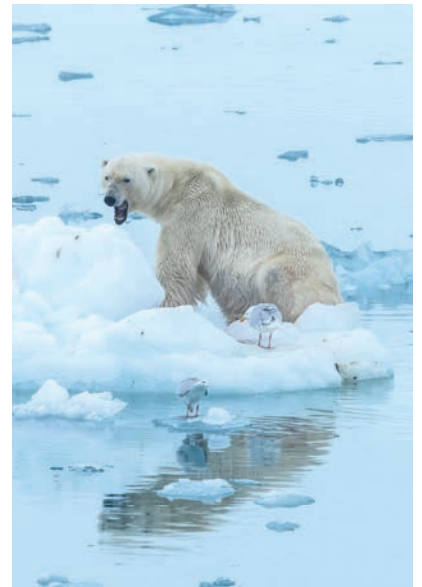
